PRIVACY POLICY

This Statement of Privacy applies to www.katemdevine.com, www.moodbarre.com and Kate M Devine / Mood Barre and governs data collection and usage. Kate M Devine / Mood Barre" "we," "us," or "our") commits to protecting your privacy. This policy "Privacy Policy") applies to our website (www.katemdevine.com) (our "Website") and our related services ("Services").

This Privacy Policy has been compiled to inform you as to how your personal information (including Personally Identifiable Information (or PII)) (collectively, "Information") is being collected, maintained, used, protected, or otherwise handled by us.

"Personally Identifiable Information" or "PII", as described in US privacy law and information security, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context. Examples of PII include names, home addresses, email addresses, phone numbers, credit card information, and internet protocol (IP) addresses.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, maintain, use, protect, or otherwise handle your Information. By using our Website, you consent to our practices described in this Privacy Policy (if you do not agree with our practices, you should not use our Website or the Services or otherwise provide us with your Information).

1) INFORMATION THAT WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

(a) When you use the Website, the Services, or otherwise contact us through the Website or otherwise via email, social media, SMS, telephone, or other methods, we may collect and use the following Information:

(i) Information you provide to us, including:

(A) Information entered into forms filled out by you on our Website or otherwise submitted to us in using our Services;

(B) Information you provide in the content of any correspondence with us (via email, social media, SMS, phone or other methods);

(C) Information provided when you register an account via our Website or otherwise sign up for our newsletter(s) and any related user preferences;

(D) Information provided by you in subscribing for any Services or placing orders on the Website;

(E) Information provided by you in any discussion boards or other through any other social media functions on our Website;

(F) Information provided by you when entering into any of our competitions, promotions, or surveys; and

(G) Information you may provide when reporting any Website or Services issues or requesting any support for your use of the Website or Services.

(ii) Internet, Device, Network Activity, or Usage Information that we collect when you use our Website or Services (which may be through the use of cookies or similar technology or local storage, such as browser-based or plugin-based local storage), including:

(A) Information related to your web-browsing behavior, cookies, or search history;

(B) Standard technical Information automatically collected when you interact with our Website or Services, including:

1. browser and device information such as unique device identifiers, mobile phone carrier, internet protocol (IP) addresses (which may identify your general geographic location), and browser types;

2. information about your visit including the dates and times of your interactions;

3. which Website pages you visited and how much time was spent on the page, page response times, download errors, page interaction details (for example, any scrolling, mouse clicks or mouse overs);

(C) The online audio, visual, and audiovisual content that has been viewed or otherwise consumed on an aggregate basis or by you individually

via our Website or Services (by viewing videos via the Website or Services, you agree we can track your video viewing history); and

(D) Information regarding your user preferences.

(iii) Information provided from other third parties and sources, which may include:

(A) Through your use of any features on our Website or via our Services that connect with such social media accounts, such Information that you permit or otherwise consent to be shared through your settings on such connect social media accounts (if you use any such features on our Website or through our Services, please review your connected account's privacy settings to control what information may be provided to us); and

(B) Information received from third parties with whom we work closely with in providing Services (including third parties who provide payment and delivery services or enable sign-on functionality and social network integration with the Website).

(b) Categories of Information that we may collect include:

(i) Identifiers, which may include your name, mailing address, email address, and phone numbers;

(ii) Demographic Information, which may include your age, date of birth, and gender;

(iii) Information about your location or time zone;

(iv) Financial Information, which may include credit cards numbers or other information used to process payments made via the Website or through the Services; and

(v) Other Internet, device, network activity, or usage Information, which may include such Information as described in Section 1)(a)(ii) above.

2) HOW YOUR INFORMATION MAY BE USED

We may use Information about you that we collect or receive, or that you provide, in the following ways (all to the extent permitted by applicable law):

(a) To provide, support, and better tailor the features of the Website or Services and to keep the Website and Services secure;

(b) To administer our Website and Services, including troubleshooting, analysis, testing, and research;

(c) To Improve our Website and the Services, including by understanding and analyzing usage trends and preferences, monitoring and analyzing the effectiveness of our Website or Services, and developing new products, services, features, and functionality to be made available via the Website or Services;

(d) To enable you, at your discretion, to participate in the interactive features of our Website and Services;

(e) To assess the effectiveness of certain advertising or content and deliver relevant advertising and content to you;

(f) For marketing purposes, such as providing you with promotional materials and content that may be useful, relevant, valuable or otherwise of interest to you, or providing your information to third parties so that they may send you promotional materials (we will obtain your prior opt-in consent to (i) send you electronic marketing communications or (ii) share your information with third parties for marketing purposes);

(g) To communicate with you for Website or Services-related purposes (including, for example, by sending an email to the email address you provide to us or text messages, to verify your account and for informational and operational purposes, such as account management, customer service, system maintenance, and other Website or Service-related purposes);

(h) With respect to any Information provided by you through your connected social media accounts, as applicable:

(i) To manage your access to and allow you to interact with the Website or Services;

(ii) To allow you to share Website or Services information to related social media platforms; and

(iii) To comply with any legal or regulatory requirements.

3) INFORMATION DISCLOSURE

We may disclose Information that we collect or receive from you to third parties only in the event that:

(a) You consent to such disclosure prior to collection of such Information; or

(b) We are under a duty to disclose or share such Information with any law enforcement organization or regulatory authority in order to comply with any legal obligations.

4) HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION?

(a) General Protective Measures.

We will take all reasonably necessary steps and precautions to protect Information we collect or receive from you and treat such Information securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We have put in place appropriate business and technical procedures to safeguard the Information that we collect and receive.

Our Website is scanned on a regular basis for security holes and known vulnerabilities in order to make your visit to our Website and use of the Services as secure as possible.

Your PII is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems and are required to keep the information confidential.

Although we may do our best to secure your Information, the transmission of Information electronically and via the internet is not 100% secure and any transmission is at your own risk. We will use strict security procedures and technology to try to prevent any unauthorized access or use of your Information that we collect or receive.

If you create a user account on our Website or to use our Services, it is your responsibility for keeping your password confidential. We will never ask you for your password, except when creating your account and when you are logging into the Website.

(b) Retention of Your Information.

We will retain your Information so long as your account with us is active or as needed to provide you Services. We will also retain your Information as required to comply with our legal obligations or to resolve disputes.

(c) Credit Card Processing / Financial Transactions.

All financial transactions are processed through a gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers. Although we do not control the security environment for our gateway providers and cannot make any guarantees regarding the secure processing of your credit card transaction Information, we do require that each of our gateway providers for credit card processing are compliant with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI-DSS).

5) FAIR INFORMATION PRACTICES

The Fair Information Practices Principles form the backbone of privacy law in the United States and the concepts they include have played a significant role in the development of data protection laws around the globe. Understanding the Fair Information Practice Principles and how they should be implemented is critical to comply with the various privacy laws that protect personal information.

In order to be in line with Fair Information Practices we will take the following responsive action, should a data breach occur:

We will notify you via email within 7 business days following any such occurrence.

We also agree to the Individual Redress Principle which requires that individuals have the right to legally pursue enforceable rights against data collectors and processors who fail to adhere to the law. This principle requires not only that individuals have enforceable rights against data users, but also that individuals have recourse to courts or government agencies to investigate and/or prosecute non-compliance by data processors.

6) COOKIES AND EXTERNAL TRACKING

(a) About Cookies

Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the site's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information.

Cookies enable us to personalize your experience on the Service, maintain a persistent session, passively collect demographic information, and monitor advertisements and other activities. For example, we use cookies to help us remember and process the items in your shopping cart.
